Meet the grantee partners whose work you're making possible.

ALBANIA

The Streha is supporting LGBTQ+ youth and refugees facing homelessness, violence, and abuse.

BURUNDI

AFRABU is increasing women's representation in local and regional leadership, including peacebuilding efforts following decades of conflict and displacement.

GUATEMALA

Wuxhtaj is training Indigenous women on human rights, preparing them to lead advocacy efforts against mining operations and hydroelectric dams that threaten communities' lands and natural resources.

HONDURAS

Cattrachas is leading evidence-based advocacy for systemic change that bolsters respect for LGBTQ+ people, including campaigns to protect LGBTQ+ youth's right to education and secure justice for gender-based violence.



INDIA

Adarsh Shiksha Sansthan is amplifying women's voices and experiences to advocate for their rights to dignified housing and tenure rights.

THE PHILIPPINES

- **Galang** is defending the socio-economic rights of urban LBT women and advocate for a national LGBTQ+ equality bill.
- **Gantala Press**, an independent feminist collective, is publishing women-centered perspectives, including those affected by the Duterte's administration repression, incarcerated women, and rural women.

SIERRA LEONE

All for All is delivering leadership programming to deaf and hearing-impaired girls and young women to address dual discrimination they experience.

TUNISIA

Ladies First is providing literacy training to agricultural women and listening centers providing legal and mental health support to women facing violence.
